Presently initiating a flood risk management project in Bangladesh. Recently, finished educational project with Nile Basin Initiative where students worked on a lot of case-studies from the Nile Basin.
2. Received EU grant for starting a new MSc programme on Flood Risk Management. The programme is of 2 year duration, starting Sep, 2011. The other partners are Technical Univ of Dresden, UPC, Barcelona and Univ of Ljubljana.
